What is Holy Name Cares?

Holy Name Cares is a Ministry of Holy Name Parish. We are your local community food bank and provide emergency food hampers to financially stressed individuals and families residing within our parish boundaries.

The Christmas Hamper Program is a special program organized by volunteers of the Holy Name Cares Ministry that shares the blessings of the Christmas season with those less fortunate than ourselves. Last year, with the help of the parish community, we provided 136 Christmas hampers to individuals and families within our

parish boundaries. It was through the generous support of parishioners and friends that we were able to provide families with food, gifts and grocery gift cards. Read on to learn more about how you can be involved in bringing the Spirit of Christmas to neighbours in our Community.
