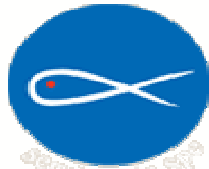

St. Vincent de Paul Hamper Program

Did you know...

- that we deliver food hampers and grocery vouchers to the needy living within our parish boundaries all year round?
- that our hamper numbers have increased 35% or 56 hampers year to date to June 30 for 2010 over 2009? (tracking in excess of 100 hampers extra for the full year)
- that Holy Name Parish SVDP delivered 83 more regular hampers in 2009 than 2008?
- that we have purchased an additional \$3700 in grocery vouchers in the first 6 months of 2010 vs 2009, while the cash donations received have decreased by more than \$2000 for this same time frame?
- that we have spent more than \$1000 for groceries in the first 6 months of 2010 over 2009?
- that if each Holy Name Parish family purchased 2 or 3 items for SVDP when they did their weekly shopping our need to purchase groceries to fill the hampers would be substantially reduced?
- that all contributions to the black basket collection or the weekly collection earmarked St. Vincent de Paul, go towards grocery or voucher purchases?
- that information on sample hampers, needed foods and volunteer roles are displayed on our webpage at www.holynameparish.org?
